TIGER SAFARI IN CENTRAL INDIAN HIGHLANDS

(Delhi / Bandhavgarh / Kanha / Pench / Delhi) 9 nights / 10 days



TOUR OVERVIEW:

Join us in Central India, a land of diverse culture, geography, flora and fauna, and home to some of the worlds rarest species of animals and birds. Our tour takes us through three of India's best tiger parks and offers amazing opportunities to view Indian wildlife up-close, in its natural habitat. The tour starts in Delhi, the capital city, before flying to central India's to visit the jungles that were the setting of Rudyard Kiplings "Jungle Book".

Our first stop is **Bandhavgarh**, situated in the Vindhya Mountains, with woodlands, rocky hills and grassland valleys. Set around an historic site with carvings, temples and an ancient fort, this park has plenty to see, including the highest concentration of vehicle friendly tigers in a tourist zone.

We continue on to **Kanha National Park**, most famous for being Rudyard Kipling's inspiration to write 'The Jungle Book'. Its topography includes lush sal and bamboo forests and open grassy meadows. The Park's landmark achievement is the preservation of the rare hard ground Swamp Deer or the Barasingha, and hence saving it from near extinction.

Our last stop is **Pench National Park**, located in the Seoni and Chhindwara districts of Madhya Pradesh. The forests of Pench are the original Kipling Land. The forest of Seoni was the setting of Rudyard Kipling's Jungle

Book. It has been included under the umbrella of Project Tiger as the 19th Project Tiger Reserve. Besides tigers, this park has the highest density of herbivores in India

DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1 – 18 April'23, Thurs Arrive Delhi

On arrival at the Delhi airport, proceed for immigration clearance after disembarking. Thereafter collect baggage from the baggage carousel and walk to the arrivals lounge after clearing customs. You will be greeted by our company representative, with a placard bearing your name on it.

You will then be transferred to your hotel close to the airport. (Check in time at the hotel is 1400 hrs / Check out time is 12 noon)

WEATHER

Mostly hot, dry and sunny. Early morning and evening game drives in open-topped vehicles can be cold (Nov to Mar). In mid-March and April temperatures during the day will be in the upper thirties centigrade but Tiger sightings at this time of year are excellent. This is because the vegetation dies away and the Tigers are drawn to the more limited water supply. By May, daytime temperatures can reach 45°C. If we can cope with this the sightings at this time of year are generally excellent and the park has very few tourists.

EQUIPMENT & CLOTHING

Casual clothing is the order of the day. Hard wearing, easy to wash travel clothes are ideal. We may wish to pack one set of slightly smarter clothes to wear at the hotels. Laundry service will be available at all the places we stay. Early morning can be cold (November to March) until the sun is up especially on game drives, in open top vehicles and in the jungle. A light windproof or fleece jacket, warm hat, gloves and scarf are recommended. During the day we will need a wide brimmed sun hat and sunglasses. Lightweight, comfortable walking shoes are advised for throughout the holiday and for sightseeing.

Special note for Wilderness: No bright colors in the field please, including brightly colored clothes, hats, gloves, etc. Although the birds and other wildlife are relatively approachable, muted colors are essential to improve our chances. We should bring a pair of binoculars in good repair. If we are keen birders we may want to bring a spotting scope. We should bring all the camera equipment, spare batteries and film that you will need. For digital camera users bring sufficient memory cards and storage. If we are using rechargeable batteries you will need to bring our charger and a travel adapter (round two pin). Plastic bags, cotton bags or pillowcases are useful to protect our camera equipment from dust and sand. A small daypack/camera bag is essential for carrying excess clothing, camera equipment and a water bottle.

 Client Names – Exactly as per Passport. For security reasons, airlines and the majority of our service providers require your name exactly as it appears in your passport. It is your responsibility to advise these details. If you or your Travel Agent do not advise the correct information and we have to re-issue airline tickets or other documentation, then we will bill you for all costs incurred, such as airline cancellation charges and courier fees, in addition to our own administration fee.

2. Travel Insurance / Trip cancellation Insurance

When paying your deposit, we would strongly suggest you take out insurance at the time against unforeseen cancellation, medical evacuation and luggage loss. Equally important is the need to check that your health and life insurance will cover you throughout your tour. The health insurance policy will need to cover you in the unlikely event of you requiring emergency evacuation or repatriation. At present we do not sell travel insurance, so this must be obtained in your country of origin.

3. Cancellations and Refunds

If it is necessary to cancel your holiday, you should notify us immediately in writing and this will take effect the day it is received by us. All monies will be forfeited as follows:

No surcharge will be made in respect of currency fluctuations once full payment has been received by the company. **However, we reserve the right to amend your tour costs up to the date of departure should there be extreme increase in hotel and transport taxes, fuel cost, game entrance park fees, government charges/taxes or other costs.**

5. Visa Requirements

Nearly all foreign visitors to India will need a tourist visa. Travelers must apply for a tourist visa online or in person at the Indian Embassy or Consulate in their jurisdiction. If the traveler cannot go in person, in some countries, this can include representatives from third party visa service companies.

Government of India Services of e-Visa involves completely <u>https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/</u> for which no facilitation is required by any intermediary / agents etc. Typically, it takes about 5-7 business days to process the online visa. E-visa applications should usually be submitted at least 60 days prior to departure to avoid rejection or application data error etc.
